The International Telecommunication Union- Development (ITU-D) Sector supports developing countries by fostering international cooperation in telecommunications and ICTs. It aims to bridge the digital divide, promote sustainable development, and drive digital transformation through policies, training, and financial strategies.

2. In the recently concluded World Telecommunications Development Conference (WTDC)-25 for ITU-D Sector at Baku, Azerbaijan, two Study Groups have been formed as below for the Study Cycle 2026-2029

- **Study Group-1:** Universal meaningful connectivity for bridging the digital divide (**5 Study questions**)
- **Study Group-2:** Digital Transformation (**5 Study Questions**)
